INTRODUCTION

CONGRATULATIONS!!

Thank you for choosing the **Reist Self Propelled AeraSeeder**. We feel confident that this equipment will meet your expectations in workmanship, reliability and performance.

This manual is to assist you with the safe operation of the AeraSeeder.

The Reist AeraSeeder is a versatile piece of equipment to facilitate various primary and over seeding requirements. It provides simple, yet accurate initial and overseeding in those "hard to get at" places. At only 33" wide, with a seeding width of 24", this mighty little machine will quickly overseed your golf greens and it can also fit through a backyard gate. The multi-spiked roller produces approximately 800 perforations per square yard, effectively saturating the top surface with a network of holes. This network, combined with our stainless steel seed apertures, brush, and smooth packing roller system, offer you the highest percentage of grass seed germination.

For primary seeding, the spike roll breaks up clumps and packs the ground. The seed is then dropped by the seeder and the brush lightly covers the seed. The smooth roll presses the soil to keep the moisture in the ground.

For over seeding the spiked roll pokes small holes into the ground. The seed that falls onto the grass is brushed into the holes created by the spiked roller. The smooth roll presses down to cover the seed and keep the moisture in.


READ OPERATOR'S MANUAL BEFORE OPERATING

Do not operate equipment until you are completely trained by a qualified operator in how to use the controls, understand the machine's capabilities, dimensions, and all safety requirements. Refer to your operator's manual for these instructions.

- Do not operate an engine in confined or non-ventilated area
- Do not perform adjustments or repairs with the engine running
- Do not operate on excessive inclines or side slopes— be careful when turning on slopes as a rollover condition may exist
- Keep bystanders away from the machine when in operation
- Be aware of pedestrians
- Know how to quickly stop the equipment in the case of an emergency

CONTROLS

- 1. Opens and closes grass seed flow
- 2. Starts, stops, and reverses Aera Seeder. This is variable speed which means the more the lever gets squeezed the faster the Aera Seeder moves.
- 3. Kill switch lever must be held to start engine.
- 4. Manual holder tube. Keep manual here for quick reference.
- 5. Hydraulic oil for Transmission. Check oil level daily.
- 6. Honda GX360 engine on/off switch. For more information see engine manual.
- 7. Turn cam to adjust amount of seed required. The higher the number, the more seed is applied.
- 8. Controls depth of brush. As bristles wear hairpin is moved to a higher hole.



OPERATION

- 1. Before starting check oil in transmission and engine.
- 2. Check gas
- 3. Close seed flow lever.
- 4. Pour grass seed into bin. Make sure it is clean seed with no dirt lumps or foreign objects.
- 5. To start engine, the engine switch must be in ON position.
- 6. Kill switch lever needs to be held to start engine.
- 7. When starting cold engine, put on choke and pull cord until engine fires.
- 8. Turn off choke.
- 9. When engine is warm choke is normally not necessary.
- 10. To move, squeeze Forward and Reverse lever. The more it is squeezed the faster the Aera Seeder will travel.
- 11. To start seeding, squeeze the Forward lever, and open the seed flow lever.
- 12. Turning a sharp corner can be done by either lifting or pushing down on the handle.
- 13. If seeding soft turf or depth needs to be controlled see section on "Adjustments".


CALIBRATION

It is easy to calibrate the seed rate and can be done in a reasonably short amount of time. All you need is a measuring tape, weigh scale, and container. Then follow the steps below.

- 1. Measure a distance of **166 ft**
- 2. Pour several pounds of seed into seed box
- 3. Insert calibration tray on mounting hooks below seed outlet at the bottom of the seeder.
- 4. Set Seed Rate Indicator to the approximate seed rate according to chart on next page.
- 5. Open seed slider and start AeraSeeder travelling at the same speed as you will be when you are seeding (approx 3 MPH/5km). Close seed slide when you pass the end mark then turn around and come back to the starting point. (If the tray is filled before getting to the end mark, stop and empty calibration tray into a container then continue. Depending on the seed rate you might have to empty the tray a couple of times.)
- 6. Weigh the collected seed and multiply the total by 3. The product is the pounds per thousand square feet.

Example: if 2.5 pounds collected in tray $3 \times 2.5 = 7.5 \text{ lbs}/1000 \text{ ft}^2$

ADJUSTMENTS

1. Tightening Drive Chains

There are three drive chains on the AOSCS24SP that need to be checked periodically. Two are tightened with idle sprockets **Fig. 6 & 7**. The chain that drives the rear roller is tightened by loosening the roller bearing. Then with a pry bar as seen in **Fig. 6** pry the bearing back until there is no slack in chain.


2. Speed Adjustment

The forward and reverse speed is adjusted by two bolts. The front bolt **Fig. 7** adjusts the reverse speed and the rear bolt towards the handle adjusts the forward speed. Turning clockwise increases speed and counter clockwise decreases speed.

3. Neutral Adjustment

If the Aera Seeder creeps when forward & reverse lever is released, adjustment needs to be made. The nuts compressing the springs in **fig.8** need to be tightened or loosened. However much one nut is tightened the other nut should be loosened.

MAINTENANCE


Refer to the General Safety Precautions, in previous pages of this manual before performing any maintenance.

- 1. At the beginning of each season, ensure that all fasteners are properly torqued, all safety guards are in place and that operator's manual is reviewed and understood
- 2. Daily, check that oil is at level mark on transmission reservoir (approx. 1/8" from bottom). Check when cool. When hot the level in reservoir will rise.
- 3. Daily, check engine oil.
- 4. Keep roller chains snug. Adjustment instructions are on preceding page.


STORAGE

- 1. Clean out seed bin.
- 2. Clean before putting into storage. May be washed with pressure washer.
- 3. Touch-up paint as needed.
- 4. Oil seeder chains.
- 5. Store in dry, ventilated area.

HANDLE & CONTROL BRACKET ASSEMBLY








TRANSMISSION TO AGITATOR DRIVE CONNECTION




